The University has launched Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) programme with the aim to develop an understanding of teaching- learning process at secondary and senior secondary level among student teachers. Its focus shall be on enabling student's teacher to reflect critically on perspectives of Education and integrate holistically the theory and practices to facilitate active engagement of learners for knowledge creation.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES: The B.Ed programme shall focus on:

- Develop an understanding of context of education in contemporary Indian society,
- Appreciating the role of context and socio-political realities about learners on facilitating learning in inclusive settings,
- Create sensitivity about language diversity in class room and its role in teaching learning process,
- Develop an understanding of paradigm shift in conceptualizing disciplinary knowledge in school curriculum,
- Identify, challenge and overcome gender inequalities in school, classroom, curricula, textbook, social institution etc,
- Enabling student teachers to acquire necessary competencies for organizing learning experiences,
- Develop competencies among student teachers to select and use appropriate assessment strategies for facilitating learning,
- Systematize experiencing and strengthening the professional competencies of studentteachers, and

Providing first-hand experience of all the school activities through engaging student- teacher as interns in secondary and senior secondary schools.
