Guest Lecture Organized on "Recent Trends in Instructional Technology"

Department of Education, BGSB University organized a Guest Lecture on "**Recent Trends in Instructional Technology**" on 14th December, 2017 from 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM in the Seminar room through video conferencing via Skype. The guest lecture was delivered online by eminent speaker: Dr. Nurkhamimi Zainuddin, Deputy Director, Centre for Global Open Access Learning, Immersive Technology and Quality Assurance, Faculty of Major Language studies, Universiti Sains Islam Malaysia (USIM), Malaysia. 
As per the feedback received from the participants it was very good learning experience, the lecture helped them in their understanding the recent trends in instructional technology.
