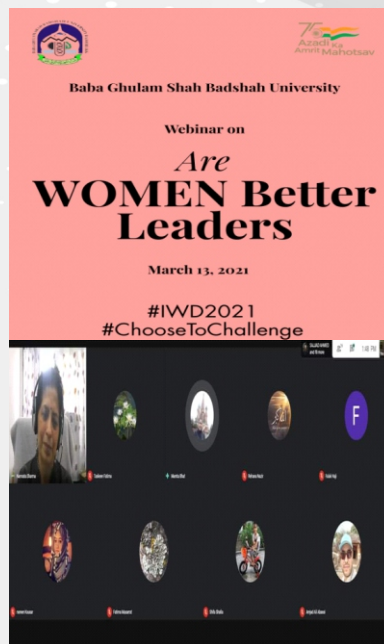

## Lecture On Gender Sensitization March, 15 -2021



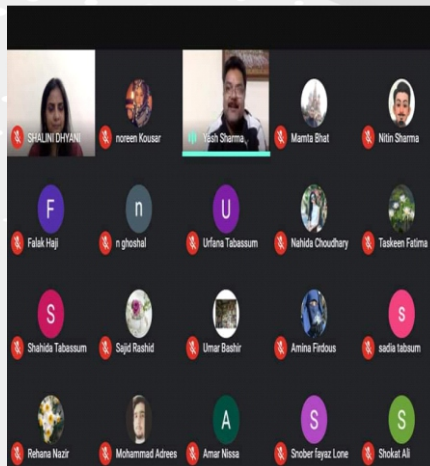

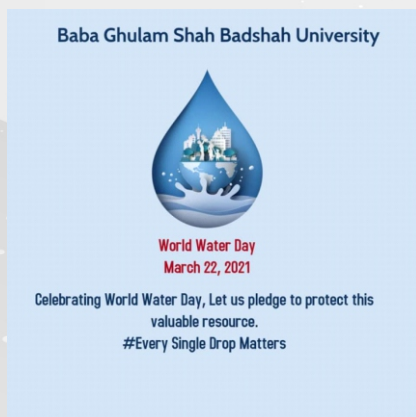
## International Day of Forests March, 21 -2021

## Health Awareness & COVID-19 Camp

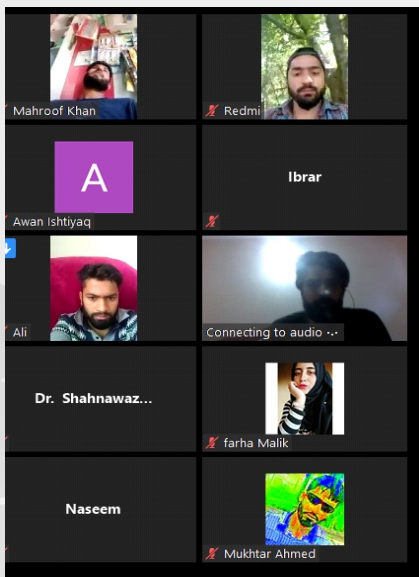
April, 7 -2021

April, 13-2021

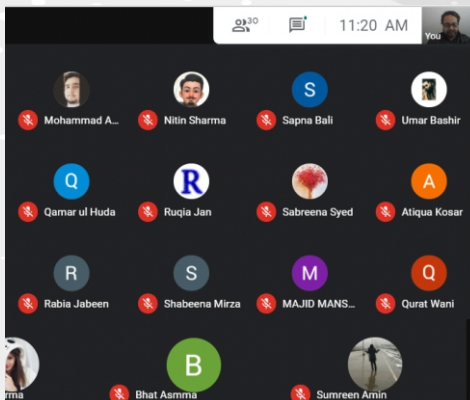

## Lecture on Climate Change

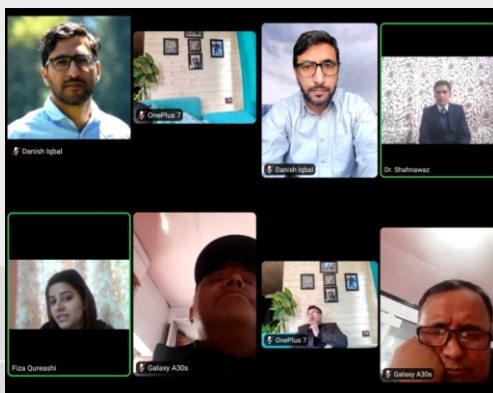
April, 17-2021

April, 18 -2021

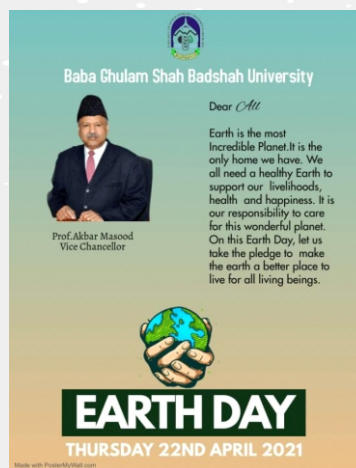

ages. Faculty members, researchers, practitioners and students from India and abroad participated in the online event.

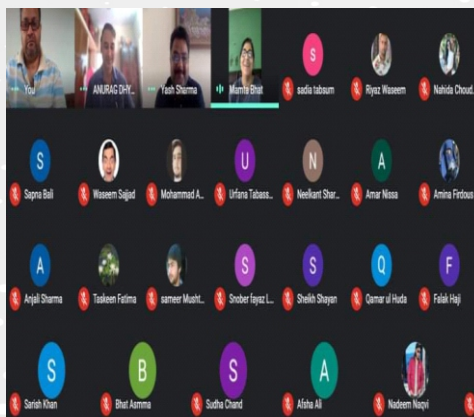
## Earth Day April, 22-2021

## Lecture on Conservation Stories of Last Known Individuals May, 07 -2021

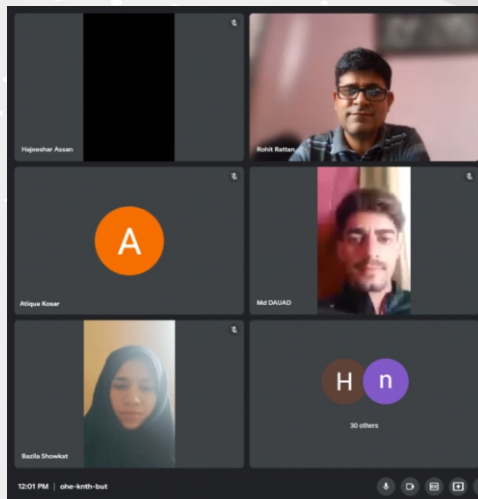

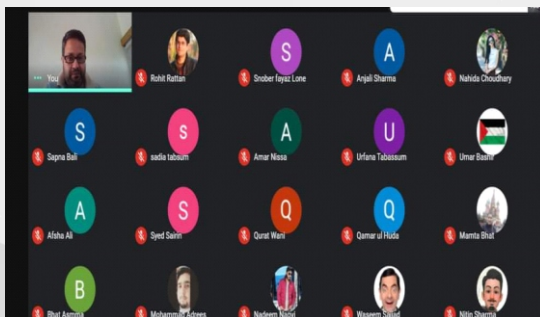


## Mother's Day May , 13 -2021

## International Day for Biological Diversity May, 22 -2021

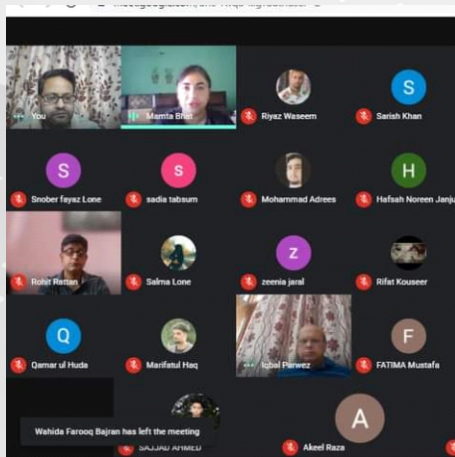

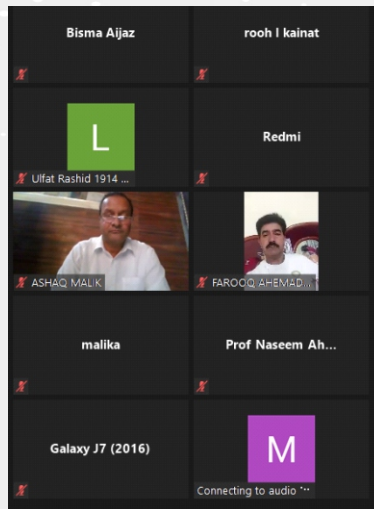
- Department of Mathematics, BGSB University organised a talk on “Understanding of Biodiversity for Nature based Solutions”.



## Awareness Programme on Substance Abuse

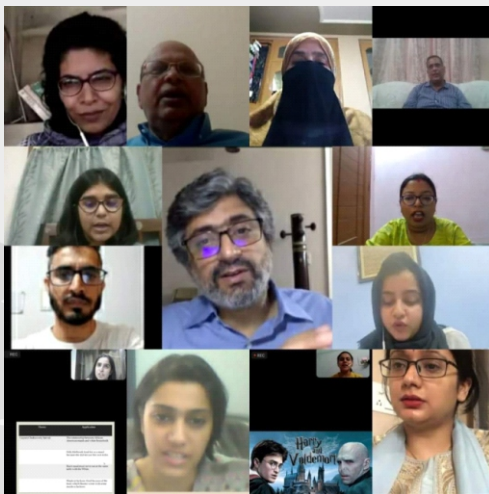
June , 09 -2021

## International day against Drug Abuse June , 26 -2021



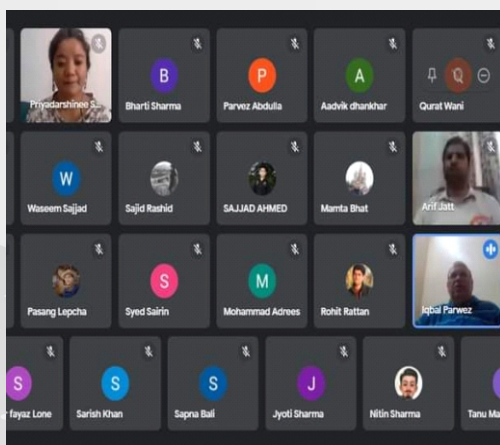

## Webinar on Approaching the Quran in Contemporary Times

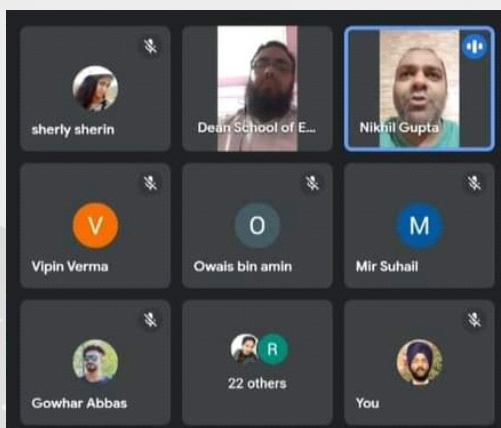
July, 08-2021

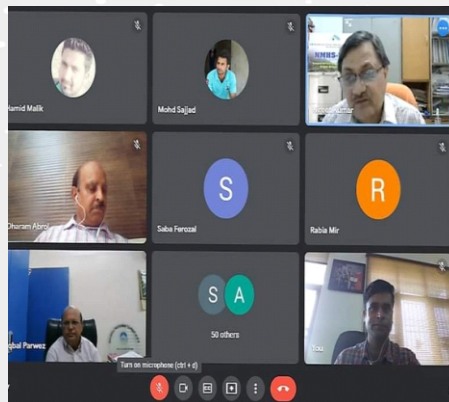
Industry. Various topics like Domains, Languages, Core areas, Dimensions of software industry were discussed.

## National Anthem singing competition August 15, 2021



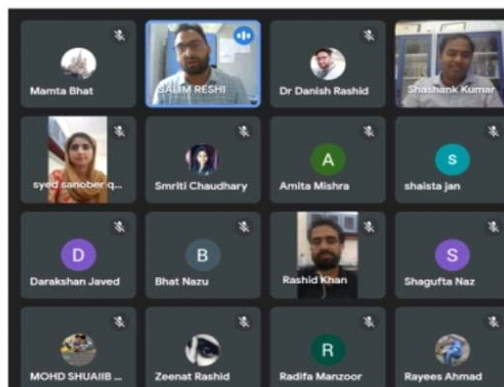

## National Webinar on Recent Advances in Anticancer Approaches of Herbal Medicine

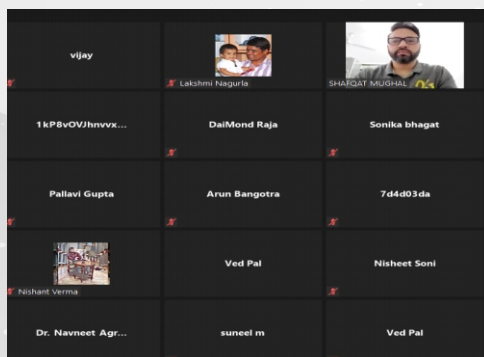
August 16, 2021

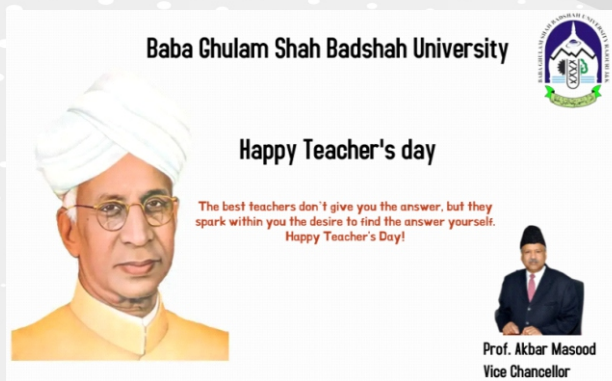
## **Jashn - e- Rajouri** **August 30, 2021**

September 18, 2021

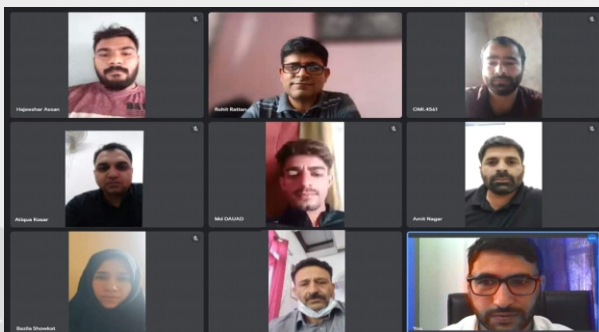

September 27, 2021

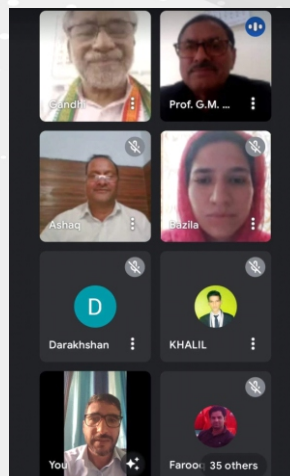

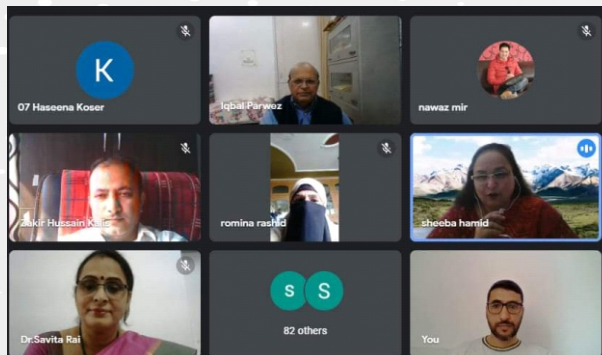


## Webinar on Inclusive Society through Gender Sensitization

Prof Akbar Masood, Vice Chancellor of the University in his messages emphasized upon the significance of vigilance and transparency in administration functioning. He further

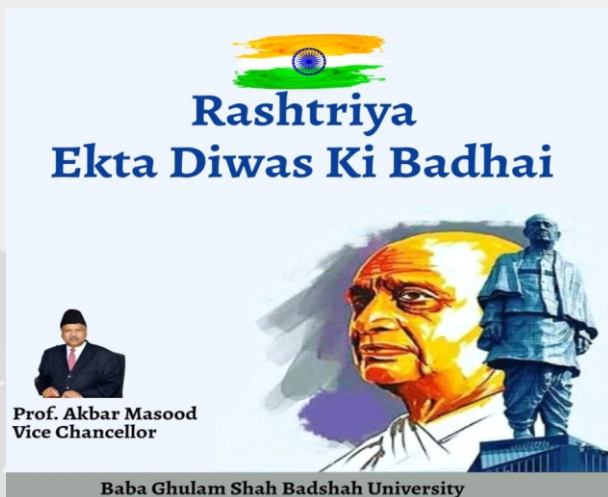
stressed that vigilance is part and parcel of administration and a vigilant system is most efficient in performing its duties towards the subjects.

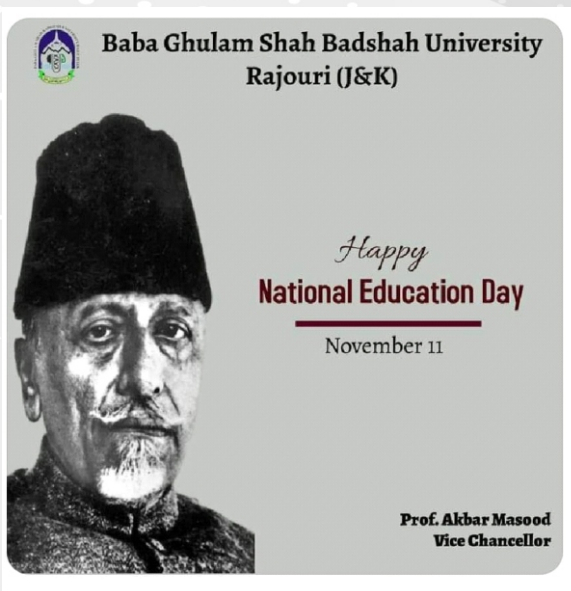
everyday life. Students from MBA, MBA Hospitality and Tourism, BBA and B.Voc participated in the workshop.



## National Education Day

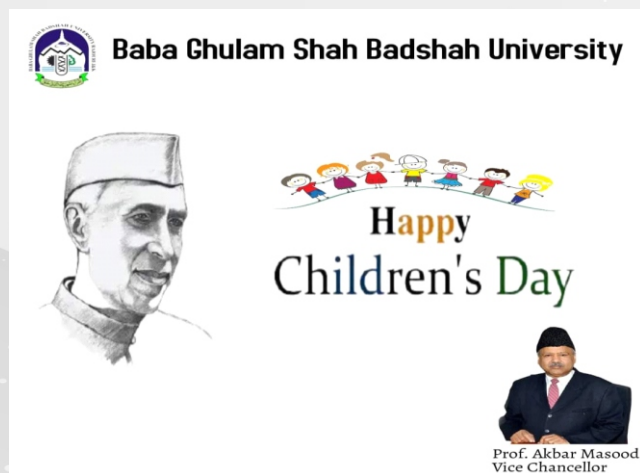
November 11, 2021

## Talent Hunt

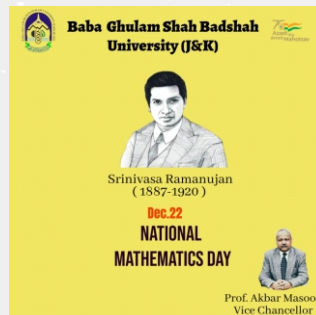
December , 20-25-2021

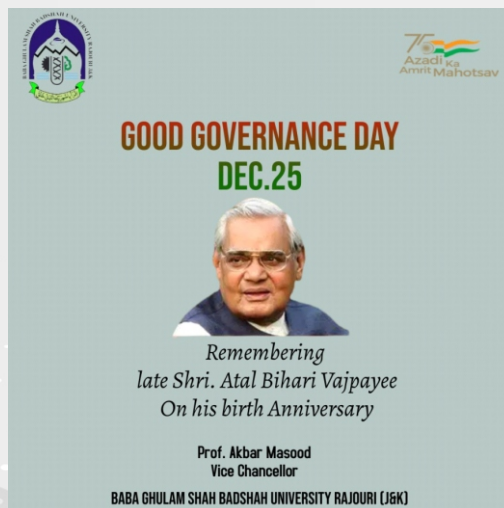


## National Consumer Rights Day December , 24-2021
