
Awareness Programme on Vigilance Week organized at Environmental Sciences, Centre for Biodiversity Studies, BGSB University

Research ethics is approached through a single course or a series of courses or seminars throughout the graduate curriculum; it has become obvious that students need exposure to ethics in a number of contexts. Webinar started with the lecture of Dean School of biosciences and biotechnology who laid emphases on Research ethics by saying that ethics can and must be taught in a formalized manner. It is our belief that courses in research ethics that incorporate a solid philosophical framework have the greatest potential for long-term usefulness to students. While other methodologies may reinforce this material, a course of the type described in this monograph has the potential to help a student develop the tools to see ethical problems from a new vantage point. It is in this context and for these reasons that we designed our course in research ethics. 



BGSBU organizes one Day National Webinar on "Inculcating Managerial Skills in Engineering Graduates"


