Baba Ghulam Shah Badshah University (BGSBU), Rajouri, J&K has been established under Act no. XVI of the J&K Legislature, published in Government gazette dated 23.04.2002. The University is recognized by the UGC under section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act.

BGSB University offers to be host institution as part of the “Global Talent Return Scheme” and invites applications from overseas Indian talent for engagement of fellows / professionals from eligible Indian scientists, academicians, researchers, and professionals currently residing/ working abroad for possible engagement under the “Ramanujan Fellowship” under the Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF) - established through an Act of Parliament: ANRF Act, 2023, (https://anrfonline.in/ANRF/Ramanujan_fellowship), strictly as per eligibility criteria, terms and conditions etc. of the Fellowship / Funding Agency. If awarded, the University shall provide necessary administrative and basic R&D infrastructure support for the duration of the fellowship; the rest of the terms will be as per the fellowship norms. The University will be under no obligation to offer regular positions to the Fellows. Detailed information of the University is available on website www.bgsbu.ac.in.

Candidates are expected to maintain an active externally funded research program, mentor graduate / postgraduate students and exhibit a strong commitment to graduate / postgraduate teaching. Currently, applications are sought in Biosciences (Biotechnology, Botany, Environment Sciences, Microbiology, Zoology) and Engineering (Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Information Technology Engineering).

Interested overseas eligible Indians as per the guidelines of the scheme may apply alongwith the following documents in a single PDF file within a period of 30 days of date of issuance of this notification on email drestab@bgsbu.ac.in.

1. Curriculum vitae.
2. Completed fellowship application. Please include a detailed statement of your future research programme.
3. PDFs of three most significant publications, along with a brief statement of impact of each paper.
4. A statement of teaching interests that details what courses you would like to teach, any prior teaching experience, and any other relevant information.
5. Name and contact information of at least three referees.
